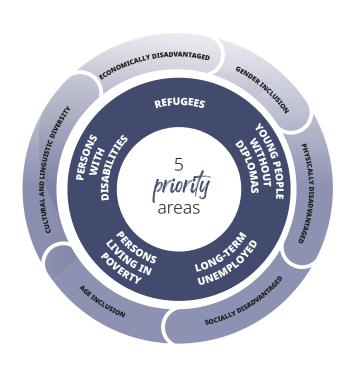


Accessible employment for all

People living in poverty

8% of the world's workers live in extreme poverty, despite having a job.

Lack of higher education leaves millions out of work in developing countries.

Nearly 50% of the long-term unemployed belong to a minority group.

Refugees and other marginalized minorities

Today, we have the highest refugee population since World War II.

People with disabilities

80-90% of people with disabilities of working age are unemployed in developing countries.

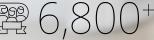

We have formed partnerships with both government and non-governmental institutions to promote economic inclusion of refugees globally. For instance, TP in Colombia collaborates with local employment agencies to host job fairs and hire Venezuelan refugees. Moreover, we have recruited and even relocated Ukrainian refugees in Europe.

FGYPT

TP employs dozens of refugees fleeing conflicts in Syria, Iraq and several African countries.

GUATEMALA

TP has partnered with Agexport and the UNHCR to offer job opportunities to refugees.

EUROPE

In 2023, TP committed to hiring 500 refugees over three years within its European operations, in partnership with the NGO TENT Partnership for Refugees. Over 300 refugees have been hired to date, mainly in Greece, Portugal, Lithuania and Poland.



When I arrived in Mexico as a refugee, I faced many challenges. But TP, through its partnership with Tent, gave me more than just a job—it gave me a chance to rebuild my life. Today, I proudly serve as a supervisor, leading a team and contributing to a company that values inclusion and growth.
